David Briley**

Councilman At-Large David Briley was raised in the Green Hills area before graduating from Montgomery Bell Academy in 1982. After attending Georgetown University, David spent a year in Latin America, teaching English and studying Spanish in impoverished areas of Ecuador and Peru. He returned to the United States and earned his law degree from Golden Gate University in San Francisco. While there, David met his wife, Jodie Bell. After his graduation in 1995, David returned to Nashville to practice law and raise a family.

David's family has a long history of public service. His grandfather, Beverly Briley, served as Metropolitan Nashville's first mayor from 1963-1975. His brother, State Representative Rob Briley, currently serves the 52nd district in the Tennessee House of Representatives, while his mother, Jeannine Briley, is a respected community leader and volunteer.

David has served on the Metro Council for the past seven years. He was named "Best Council Member" by the Nashville Scene for three of his seven years of service (2001, 2002, and 2006). He has maintained a special focus on ethics, budget, and government efficiency issues. In 2002, he was named as one of the "Top 40 under 40" by Business Nashville.

David is now running for mayor of Metropolitan Nashville and has made education, public safety, and sustainable development his top priorities. David, Jodie, and his son Sam, who is 3, currently live in Inglewood.
