OUR DEEPEST SYMPATHY

Retired state Criminal Court of Appeals Judge Allen Robinson Cornelius died Monday, January 22nd after a long illness.

Judge Cornelius was a past president and long time board member of the Exchange Club of Nashville. He was a co-founder of the Davidson County Veterans' Coordinating Council, and a leader of the boy Scouts of America which bestowed on him its Long Rifle Award.

Quoting from Sheila Burke's tribute in Wednesday's *Tennessean*, "Those who knew Judge Cornelius remembered him as a man who stood up for his principles. He ran a tight ship in the courtroom but was always fair.

"Judge Cornelius, a native of Nashville, served as an Army medical corpsman in Europe during World War II. He graduated from the Cumberland School of Law in 1947 and began his legal career as a casualty claims attorney for USF&G insurance agency before entering private practice.

"He won a two-year term in the Tennessee House of Representatives in 1953, and he was elected as a general sessions judge in 1958, serving as a criminal court judge from 1968 to 1978. He continued to act as a special judge in state courts, including the State Supreme Court for years after his retirement in 1987.

"He is survived by his wife, Ruth; son, Allen R. Cornelius, III, of Fairfax, Va.; daughters, Ruth O'Loughlin, Houston, Lucinda Cobb of St. Louis, Anne Cornelius of Arlington, Va.; and Mary Cornelius of Goodlettsville."

A funeral mass will be celebrated at 1:00 p.m., Fri., January 26, at the Cathedral of the Incarnation. The family will receive visitors Fri., from 10 – 11:30 a.m. at Marshall Donnelly Combs Funeral Home.
