William S. "Bill" Cochran

Managing Partner Emeritus,
Northwestern Mutual Financial Network

"Time of My Life"

**Mr. Cochran will discuss his activities as a volunteer
for United Way since retiring from Northwestern
Mutual in 2002.**

Over the course of Bill Cochran's 35-year career as Managing Partner, he led the Agency's expansion throughout Middle/East Tennessee and Northern Alabama, as well as its evolution from a small life insurance agency to a sophisticated financial services company.

In 1967, Mr. Cochran assumed a leadership position with 12 agents and \$280 million of life insurance in force. At the time of appointment, he became the youngest managing partner in company.

At the time of Bill's retirement in 2002, he was the most tenured Managing Partner in the company; he had \$12.0 billion of life insurance in force, as well as the largest life agency in the state of Tennessee.

A philanthropic activist, Cochran has served on numerous boards and worked with local and national nonprofit organizations to raise millions of dollars. By focusing specifically on successful fundraising and development models, he has enabled many organizations to increase their base of support. He currently serves on the National Tocqueville Committee for United Way, leads United Way's Team Tennessee effort to develop Tocqueville Societies, which have had a remarkable 57% growth rate over the past five years.

A native Nashvillian, Cochran graduated from Vanderbilt University in 1959. He and his wife, Anita, have been married for 47 years, and have three children and four grandchildren.

2008 Exchange Club Charities Grant Application

The Board of Directors recommends the following proposed amendments to the Exchange Club of Nashville Bylaws:

Section 17 is hereby amended by replacing "eleven elected members" with "nine elected members."

Explanation: This section is amended to make it consistent with Section 22, which specifies that elected members of the Board, other than officers, are elected in classes of three: three elected for two-year terms and three elected for one-year term, with the current year's two year directors serving their second year to fill out the final three slots. We have five one-year directors this year, which number will be reduced to three by this amendment.

Section 22 is hereby amended to add the office of President-Elect as an office to be filled. The President-Elect shall move into the office of President after one year of service as President-Elect. The incumbent President shall serve as Chair of the Nominating Committee.

Explanation: President-Elect was inadvertently omitted from the list of officers to be nominated. The appointment of the Chair clarifies who is responsible for convening the Nominating Committee.

Section 22 is hereby amended to add the office of Assistant Secretary as an office for which the Nominating Committee shall nominate a candidate. The Assistant Secretary shall serve one year as Assistant Secretary followed by a second year as Secretary.

Explanation: The Assistant Secretary has been appointed by the President in the past. Since the Assistant Secretary has always moved to Secretary in the following year, it should be an elected office.

The above amendments will be voted on at the Tuesday, April 29, 2008 meeting.
