Beth is the editor and publisher of *NFocus* magazine. *NFocus* provides coverage for charitable events in Nashville and Middle Tennessee which promotes non-profit causes. The magazine has an in-depth knowledge of community, board and non-profit infrastructures, stakeholders, donors and recipients.

Since joining *NFocus*, the magazine has increased ad revenue by 30% per annum in 2004, 2005, 2006, increased editorial pages by 35%; increased circulation by 50% in 2002 and coordinated editorial content with 15-18 monthly contributors.

Beth has also been a ghost writer for the autobiography of Joel Gordon (2007), and the Editor of *Love & Kisses, Herbert*, a compilation of columns by *NFocus* founder Herbert Fox, published 2008 by Eveready Press.

Prior to joining *NFocus* magazine, Beth served as the Vice President, Major Gifts for the United Way of Metro Nashville. During her tenure at the United Way, she helped raise more than \$8 million annually through direct requests and various campaign initiatives; identified and recruited three new Million Dollar Roundtable donors; implemented innovative 21st Century Match plan to grow annual Alexis de Tocqueville individual gifts from \$10,000 to \$25,000 over three years, as well as several other accomplishments.
