**Kathy Rayburn**  
**Currey Ingram Academy**

Kathleen G. "Kathy" Rayburn arrived at Currey Ingram Academy (then Westminster School of Nashville) in 1995. As head of the school, her fundraising accomplishments included a \$23 million dollar capital campaign to build a new campus in 2002, and an \$11.2 million dollar drive for the school's first-ever Upper School building in 2007. She also broadened the school's mission to include grades 9 thru 12.

A veteran member of local and regional boards, Ms. Rayburn currently serves on the National Board of Bridge Multimedia, a New York City-based company dedicated to supporting all facets of universally accessible media.

Prior to Currey Ingram, Ms. Rayburn spent 18 years at Orchard Country Day School in Indianapolis, IN, where she served as classroom teacher, head of support services, school psychologist and finally, interim head. She also designed and helped implement the school's first written curriculum and included programs for gifted students and those with learning differences. As a professor at Butler University in the early 1990s, she created and taught a course on remedial strategies for school psychologists.

Rayburn's speaking credits include keynote speaker for the 1993 meeting of progressive educators in Washington, D.C. She also served as the American Ambassador to China in 1999 for the education exchange organization, The People-to-People Program, where she counseled China's minister of education on reading comprehension strategies.

Rayburn received her school psychology license and master's degree in reading from Butler University.
