**“The Entrepreneurial Mind”**

Belmont's Center for Entrepreneurship offers a hands-on approach to help you hit the ground running, thanks to its co-curricular environment. Student entrepreneurs are given the opportunities to work in student-run retail spaces on campus or develop their own business ventures with the support of their professors. This hands-on approach equips students with the knowledge, skills and experience needed to be a successful entrepreneur.

Mr. Cornwall's interest in entrepreneurship came early in life. He grew-up with entrepreneurship and small business as topics around the dinner table at night. His family was involved in many ventures. His father left a career in corporate America to pursue an entrepreneurial career in the mid-1970s. Today his father is an active, octogenarian entrepreneur.

At Belmont, Mr. Cornwall is the inaugural Jack C. Massey Chair in Entrepreneurship. Previously, he was the Sandra Schulze Chair in Entrepreneurship at the University of St. Thomas in St. Paul, Minnesota and was on the faculty at the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh and the University of Kentucky. He has a Doctorate in Business Administration and an MBA from the University of Kentucky, and an undergraduate degree from the University of Wisconsin - Stevens Point.

In the late 1980's, Mr. Cornwall felt the entrepreneurial calling in life and left academics to become the Co-founder and President/CEO of Atlantic Behavioral Health Systems, headquartered in Raleigh, NC. The company operated a variety of health care facilities and programs and employed over 300 people. After nine years of rapid growth, they negotiated the sale of most of the corporations' business interests, and he returned to academics.

Mr. Cornwall consults with a variety of businesses on start-up and growth related issues.

His current research and teaching interests include entrepreneurial finance and entrepreneurial ethics. He authored or co-authored six books. His latest two books are *Bringing Your Business to Life*, due out in the summer of 2008 and *Bootstrapping*, due out in 2009.
