**Albie Del Favero
Publisher,
Nashville City Paper**

A native Nashvillian, Del Favero, put together an investment group in 1988 to purchase controlling interest in a weekly shopper known as the *Nashville Scene*. He and his partner, Bruce Dobie, repositioned the *Scene* to create Nashville's first successful alternative weekly newspaper. In 1995 they started *Nfocus* with partner and founding editor, Herbert Fox.

He served as publisher of the *Scene* from 1988 to 1999. In 2000, he was a partner in the leveraged buyout of Village Voice Media, which rolled six other alternative weeklies, including New York's *Village Voice*, into the *Nashville Scene* and *Nfocus*. He served as executive vice-president and group publisher of the company's weekly papers in Seattle, Minneapolis, Cleveland and Nashville. He joined the City Paper in 2006.

Del Favero started his newspaper career in 1975 as an advertising salesman at the *Clarksville Leaf-Chronicle*, after earning a B.S. degree from the University of Tennessee. Before moving back home to Nashville to purchase the *Scene*, he held various positions in Atlanta, Boston and New York with the national advertising rep firm, C.W.O.&O.

During his tenure at the *Scene*, Del Favero served as president of the Association of Alternative Newsweeklies from 1997-1999. He is also past president of Friends of Centennial Park and the Parthenon, now the Conservancy, and a former president of Historic Nashville. He has also served on the boards of Matthew 25, the Nashville Advertising Federation, Gilda's Club of Nashville and West End United Methodist Church. Albie is an alumnus of Leadership Nashville class of 1997. He and his wife Sara have two daughters: Perry, 21 and Elle, 17.
