**Topic:**

**“United Way and Nashville – We are in this Together”**

On August 23, 2007, the United Way of Metropolitan Nashville announced the appointment of Dan Gaudette as interim president and CEO. Dan joins United Way from a prestigious and lengthy career with Nissan North America. As a senior vice president for Nissan North America, he oversaw all manufacturing and supply chain management functions for Nissan's three manufacturing plants in the United States and its two plants in Mexico. He retired from Nissan in April 2007.

Gaudette has been involved with United Way of Metropolitan Nashville over the years as an executive board member, Tocqueville Society member, and volunteer.

A Nissan employee for more than 26 years, Gaudette has held variety of positions within the company. Starting in 1980 as an accountant, Gaudette was promoted to department manager, project manager, and then director/plant manager in Manufacturing. He became the vice president of Manufacturing in January 1998, senior vice president of U.S. Manufacturing in October 1999 and senior vice president of North American Manufacturing and Supply Chain in April 2004. He retired from this position in April of 2007.

Prior to working for Nissan, Gaudette worked as an accountant at Ford Motor Co. and an industrial engineer at Great Lakes Steel.

He earned his bachelor's degree in finance from Central Michigan University in Mount Pleasant, Michigan, and an MBA from Eastern Michigan University in Ypsilanti, Michigan.

Gaudette serves as a director of the Nashville branch of the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta, a member of the advisory board of the Bank of America, and an *ex officio* board member of the Nashville Zoo at Grassmere. He is a cabinet member of the Governor's Books from Birth Foundation, which provides free books to children from birth to age five throughout the state of Tennessee. He is a member of the Professional Advisory Board of the Jennings A. Jones College of Business at Middle Tennessee State University. He has also served on the executive board of the United Way of Metropolitan Nashville and the board of trustees for Leadership Nashville. He is an alumnus of Leadership Nashville.
