Dr. Ian Brick**

Dr. Brick grew up in Belfast in the 1960's and worked in Northern and Southern Ireland before emigrating to the United States in 1984. His talk will center on his first hand experiences on living in Ireland before, during, and after the conflict and how it relates to current events.

Dr. Brick has a distinguished record of both management and research achievement in the pharmaceutical industry. He received a degree in Physiology and then a Ph.D in Pharmacology from Queen's University, where he was also President of the Student's Union. From 1968 to 1977, he rose quickly into senior management at ICI Pharmaceuticals in the United Kingdom. Dr. Brick had a series of executive and research positions with firms in Ireland. In 1984 he became President of ICP Incorporated, a U.S. clinical contract research company. From 1987 to 1989 he was President and Acting CEO of HEM Research, Inc. based in Philadelphia, a start-up health care company with a number of products under development for treatment of cancer and immune disorders, particularly AIDS. From 1990 to 1994, Dr. Brick successfully presided as President over Pharmaceutical Laboratory Services.

Since his retirement in 1994, Dr. Brick and his late wife, Katherine, focused on energizing America's ties with Northern Ireland. A key player in the Atlantic Bridges project to build cultural links between Northern Ireland and the American South, Dr. Brick was instrumental in the twinning of Belfast and Nashville as Sister Cities in 1996. He is also involved with Queen's University where he is one of the founding members of the University's Foundation Board. He assumed the role as formal ambassador for Queen's in the United States and helped to establish the first Queen's Graduate Association. Dr. Brick received an honorary D.Sc. in Economics from Queen's University Belfast in December, 2002.
