The Nature Conservancy is the leading conservation organization working around the world to protect ecologically important lands and waters for nature and people.

Topic:

"Free Market Approaches to Conservation"

Scott Davis served with the Ohio Chapter of The Nature Conservancy for six years, serving first as Director of Conservation Programs and later as the Associate Director. While in Ohio he also served as Acting Director for the Wisconsin Chapter. In May of 2000 Scott accepted the position as Executive Director of the Tennessee Chapter, and now lives with his wife and four children in Franklin, TN. Areas of interest include aquatic ecology, sustainable and compatible resource use and issues associated with sprawl and unplanned development.

Scott received undergraduate and graduate degrees in aquatic ecology from Miami University and Texas A&M University respectively. Prior to working with The Nature Conservancy, he spent approximately 13 years living and working in Belize, Ecuador, Indonesia, and the Bahamas on a variety of fishery, aquaculture and coastal management projects. Early in his career Scott also spent time working for Texas A&M University, Texas Parks and Wildlife and the Ohio Department of Natural Resources.
