Colonel Art Huber is the Commander, Arnold Engineering Development Center, Air Force Material Command, Arnold Air Force Base in Tennessee. He oversees the largest and most advanced complex of flight simulation test facilities in the world. These test facilities simulate flight from subsonic to hypersonic speeds at altitudes from sea level to space. All NASA manned spacecraft and every high performance aircraft, missile, space launch system and most military satellites in use by the Department of Defense today have been tested in the center's facilities.

The Center was recently audited by Tennessee Department of Children's Services and achieved a "perfect score" in both counties. An agency is rated on 126 standards; the Center was scored "compliant" or "not applicable" on all 126! This is a first for our Center!

For a center to be affiliated with and carry the name of "Exchange Club" it must meet the requirements of The Standards of Operation and Practice as set forth by The National Exchange Club Foundation's Board of Trustees. The end result of an eight month process to achieve accreditation is a rating of "AAA" with a score of 120 points; another first for our center.
