Exchangites, Why Do We Do It?

When you are cooking hamburgers, organizing a golf tournament, planning a horse show, working field day at a local school, choosing a youth-of-the-month, selling tickets, recruiting, soliciting contributions, building a new club, or participating in any of the many other service projects that are a part of Exchange, do you ever say, "Why am I doing this?"

One of the highest priority topics of the day is juvenile crime. Experts list the following as major contributors: poverty, community and family issues, single parent households, gangs, access to guns, truancy and dropout rates, hunger, addictions, lack of parental concern, and living in an urban setting. Guess what...those issues mirror many of the causes of child abuse and neglect!

In addition to the commonality of causes of child abuse and neglect and juvenile crime, statistics show that 20% of abused and/or neglected children are convicted of a serious juvenile crime, 24% of juvenile offenders are incarcerated, and that only 16% of abused and/or neglected children ever have court action taken on their behalf.
